The **7- Petals of SSL Logo** represent the 7 areas of development as identified by us. The SSL focusses on these seven key developmental areas by ensuring that all skills are nurtured and enhanced for an all-round development of children.



1. Cognitive development

Cognitive learning is a style of learning that focuses on more effective use of the brain. Cognition is the mental process of gaining knowledge and understanding through the senses, experience and thought. Activities are designed to build and improve child observational skills, information processing, understanding concepts, problem solving and predicting outcomes.

2. Language Development

Language learning is important for children as it gives them a learning advantage in every field. Activities are designed to improve listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.



3. Fine Motor Development

Fine motor relates to the development of small muscles of child. Creative activity are designed that involve small muscles by honing the artistic abilities of children to improve creativity and pincer grip in children.



4. Gross Motor Development

Gross motor relates to the development of large muscles. Activities are designed that involve large muscles like running, jumping to build physical strength and develop better coordination and balance.

5. Personal Awareness

SUBMISSION's BLN Programme

Literacy empowers and liberates an individual and people at large. Beyond its importance as part of the right to education, literacy improves lives by expanding capabilities which in turn reduces poverty, increases participation in the labour market and has positive effects on health and sustainable development.

Literacy, the ability to read and write, is arguably the single most important factor in determining a student's life and career arc. For those who cannot, the options are extremely limited and even an unskilled minimum wage job can be difficult to obtain. While Numeracy skills refer to the ability to use, interpret and communicate mathematical information to solve real-world problems. These include the ability to understand basic math like addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

Our **Basic Literacy & Numeracy** (BLN) program is aimed at helping the Government's initiative of improving literacy of our beloved Nation. The course is split into 3 levels.



SUBMISSION's BLN Programme

Level-I:

वर्णमाला (अ से ज्ञ), बिना मात्रा के शब्द,

Alphabet recognition, Sounds (vowel and consonant), Basic Word Formation.

Number 1 to 100, After, before and between numbers, 2 digit Additions and subtraction.

Level-2

मात्रा ज्ञान, वाक्य रचना, अपठित गद्यांश,

Sentence Formation, Unseen passage, Reading paragraphs, Use of determinants, Articles.

Number upto 1000, Additions and subtraction, Multiplication, Number names.

Level-3:

कहानी लेखन, पत्र लेखन

Sentence Formation, Picture description, sentence translation, Reading Additions and subtraction, Multiplication, Division, word problems, Basic geometry.



SUMMER EXCELLENCE CLASS PROGRAMME

Summer programs have been viewed as a separate academic component of the educational efforts, and served mostly to the students who needed an extra chance to pass a course or state test. It also provided students with opportunities to reinforce a skill not gained during the regular school year.

The Submission School of Learning like every year, organized Summer Excellence Classes for the students of the school this year too. The class comprised a mix of academic studies and enrichment activities designed to support academic re-engagement, motivate and enthuse students. The programme was based around the core theme of developing a love for reading and learning among students. We focused on academic learning in English, Science, and Maths. In English lessons, students learnt passage writing, comprehension and sentence formation. There were also a range of creative writing tasks to inculcate the habit of writing.


PROJECT EXHIBITION

Then we came across a garden area where Deer and Stags were taking their strolls. These animals were very playful, smart, beautiful, and a pleasure to watch. In one of the corners, we saw a huge tree where baboons and monkeys were jumping from one branch to the other. They were very active and funny. They were playing pranks and tricks on one another.


